GENERAL CONDITIONS

ENTRY

1. Entries close midnight Monday, 26 August 2024, all entries must be received prior, no late entries accepted.
2. The Art Prize is non-acquisitive.
3. Entries are limited to no more than **three (3)** items in EACH SECTION.
4. Entry fees are non-refundable. Entry Fee Sections 1-3 \$20 per work, Section 4 Entry Fee \$15 per work. Youth entries are FREE in Sections 5-8.
5. Enter ONLINE ONLY at www.frostoverbarraba.org.au. If this is not possible or if assistance is needed, contact the Exhibition Coordinator to assist.
6. Entry size must be no greater than 1m x 1m for 2D, or 1m cubed for 3D, INCLUSIVE of frame/display apparatus. NOTE size limitations for DEPOT delivery items below.
7. A work may consist of multiple parts but combined must not exceed overall size limits.
8. All works must be original work of the entrant, created in the last two years and not previously exhibited at Frost Over Barraba Art Exhibition.
9. No alterations to Artist or Artwork details will be accepted after entries close.
10. The Committee reserves the right to transfer any entry to any other section or to not exhibit an entry for any reason.
11. The Committee reserves the right to have any entry reproduced in the press, by telecast, or online for the purposes of advertising the Exhibition or future Frost Over Barraba Exhibitions.
12. Excluding Convenor/Marketing and Exhibition Co-ordinator, committee members of Frost Over Barraba are eligible to enter, however are NOT eligible for the Best Work or Packers Prize.
13. Each Artwork is eligible for one prize only.
14. NOVICE PRIZE: Artists entered in sections 1-4 who have not previously won a prize for artwork at Frost or any other Art Show are eligible to enter the Novice Prize. Eligibility is noted via the Online Entry Form.

LABELLING

15. Please download and print labels from www.frostoverbarraba.org.au to provide Artist's name, address, title of work, section, medium used, price and collection.
16. Labels are to be attached to each 2D Work at the back and 3D work in a suitable position.

HANGING

17. Section 1 PAINTING & Section 2 WORKS ON PAPER: All works must be dry, framed or mounted, ready to hang with hanging wire attached.
18. Sections 4 & 6 PHOTOGRAPHY: Works must be mounted on a rigid backing, with matt optional, and do not need to have hanging attached. Wood, chipboard, masonite and similar will not be accepted.
19. Photography printed on canvases will NOT be accepted.
20. Framed photography WILL be accepted and MUST have HANGING attached. Hook or claw style hanging fixtures NOT accepted.
21. Sections 7 & 8 YOUTH ART: All works must be dry. Works on paper ARE accepted, preferably mounted on cardboard or rigid backing, but not essential. Framed or stretched canvas works must be ready to hang with hanging wire attached.

SALES

22. All Artworks must be for sale, excepting YOUTH Sections, 5-8.
23. **Sales commission of 25%** will be deducted from all sales (excepting Youth Sections 5-8 for which NIL commission is charged). Please price your work accordingly.

HAND DELIVERY TO BARRABA

24. The Treloar's Building, 75 Queen Street on **Saturday, 31st August** between 10am and 3pm. No late deliveries will be accepted.

FREIGHT/DEPOT

25. No entry forms will be accepted at any depot.
26. Depot Delivery size limit: Only artworks less than 800mm x 800mm will be accepted at DEPOTS. For Sculpture/3D entries wishing to use Depots, please contact Exhibition Co-ordinator to ensure transport space is available. Artists with larger or fragile Artworks are encouraged to deliver personally, or via Courier.
27. Artworks to be delivered to DEPOTS by 4pm Wednesday, 28 August.
28. Artworks may also be freighted using a Courier service or Australia Post to Frost Over Barraba, 75 Queen St, BARRABA NSW 2347. They must arrive by Friday, 30 August.
29. **Freight will be \$5** for each work using depots, which includes delivery from and back to the depot.

30. Frost Over Barraba Committee Members, Volunteers, Depots and Carriers accept no liability for loss or damage in transit or while on exhibition. All possible care will be taken with Artworks, insurance costs are to be met by the entrant.
31. Works will be available for collection from depots from 16 to 20 September.
32. Return of unsold works to DEPOT to be noted clearly in the entry AND on the Artwork label.

COLLECTION

33. Unsold works are to be collected on **Sunday, 8 September** between 2pm to 4pm.
34. For the security of works, a removal protocol will be in place. Exhibition doors will close at 1pm on Sunday, 8 September and works will be available for collection from 2pm to 4pm. If works are to be returned to a DEPOT please note this clearly on the entry form and Artwork label.
